

MF Geographical Areas

MARDAN Foundation is registered under Social Welfare Act of 1961 and working in Khyber Pukhtunkhwa province of Pakistan. For the time being MARDAN Foundation has its head office in Mardan City and field offices in different union councils of Mardan. Its management has decided to focus on different areas of Mardan Division including a sister district Swabi. The team of MARDAN Foundation has also enhanced its geographical area to other parts of Pukhtunkhwa. The volunteer of MF are working in Peshawar Division helping the victims of Flood in Nowshera and Charsadda districts of Peshawar Division, while the team of MF has also focused on Malakand Division.

Position of Mardan

Mardan Division has a very strategic position in the Khyber Pukhtunkhwa. The total area of Mardan district is about 1,632 sq kms. It is clear from the MAP that Malakand, Charsadda, Nowshera, Swabi and Bunir districts surround the District Mardan.

Mardan Division is hilly in the northeast, while the southwestern half is a fertile plain. Generally streams flow from north to the south. Most of the streams drain into the Kabul River. The summer season is extremely hot. During May and June dust storms are frequent during the night. Most of the rainfall occurs in the months of July, August, December, and January.
